Children will require tennis shoes and comfortable clothing to run around in; a packed lunch and plenty to drink.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Drama Camp – “Create your own Production” with Mike Kasin</i></b></p> <p>Students will run through the gambit of writing, directing, set, prop, costume building &amp; design, &amp; performing their own original work. Students choose their own themes, then under the guide of a professional director they work through the “Brechtin” approach to creating new works. They will end with a 45-minute production completely realized &amp; created by the students. A great way for students to see how much work is involved in the entire process of putting on a production &amp; to use art to speak to issues relevant to the students themselves;</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Create your own Production is a hit class wherever it is introduced.</b></p>

By building age appropriate projects the students will learn the safe and proper use of hand tools. They will discover the excitement of making useful and playful items for themselves and their families.
