Class Descriptions

Woodworking

Have fun creating & designing a woodworking project that you can take home. You will be proud knowing that you built it yourself. You will learn how to use tools and machines to build well-crafted projects. Mr. Kucharski has 22 years of experience teaching students how to use tools safely. If you are creative & like to build this is the class for you.

Cooking

This cooking class will teach basic knife skills, recipe following skills, how to take a recipe to a new level, and ingredient lessons. Kids will learn how to cook meals and make their favorite foods. Recipes that are made throughout the classes will be given to the kids to take home and make for their families.

Mandarin Chinese
