Winter/Spring 2012 Class Descriptions

<p align="center">Hip/Hop Acrobatics</p> <p>Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of movement and timing. We will learn how to stretch and have fun learning jazz technique as well as creative dance moves for the dance floor! This class will be a blend of today's high-energy "street style" dancing. Comfortable, fitted clothing recommended. No jeans, due to lack of material flexibility</p>	<p align="center">Knitting</p> <p>Come and learn the relaxing hobby of knitting. We'll learn the basics: Casting on, knitting, purling, binding off and sewing with yarn. Students will get an instruction book with needles, crochet hook and yarn. Children will pick a simple project like a scarf or a small bag to work on throughout the class.</p>	<p align="center">Taiko Drumming</p> <p>Jimi is a professional Taiko artist. He has played all over the world and studied his art in Japan. His class description: "Learning to play Taiko" Japanese Taiko can be a fun experience for children. In our class children will ho to strike the drum, to play together and to fell the joy of hearing the unique sound of the Taiko.</p>
<p align="center">Cooking</p> <p>Let's get cooking! We will be learning to make a variety of items, from sandwiches to salad, cupcakes and fondue. Topics also include cooking safety and using the microwave - and we will have a field trip to our local organic garden & chicken coop at Plowshares! By the end of the class, your child will be able to safely make all the recipes in their personal cookbook, and just might give you a run for your money in the kitchen! PLEASE NOTE: All allergies must be noted to the instructor before your child is allowed to attend class. This is a peanut free class.</p>	<p align="center">Mandarin</p> <p>Class for Grade 1-5 – Students learn Pinyin, conversation, characters, singing, games, etc. The class allows students to actively participate for developing their interest in Chinese language and culture. The class will be separated by grade if over maximum. Class for Kinder-Only – To foster students' interest in the new language. Students learn nursery rhyme, pictograms through dancing, games and much more. Show Time – Perform at school events</p>	<p align="center">Carpentry</p> <p>Students will discover the fun of building and working with wood. By building age appropriate projects the students will learn the safe and proper use of hand tools. They will discover the excitement of making useful and playful items for themselves and their families. Classes will begin by teaching simple skills such as using a hammer to drive nails, and move to each student successfully building a project that will range from a piece of furniture for a stuffed toy, to a foot stool or bird feeder.</p>

OYC alumni include LaToya London (American Idol Season 3).</p>	<p align="center">Mad Science- "Crazy Chem. Works"</p> <p>Use your hands as a real Mad Scientist in this whirlwind class on how a lab works! Students will learn to recognize chemical reactions and mix up a few reactive ingredients for some sensational results. We will explore the pH extremes with our Reaction Tubes in what is sure-to-be a popping experience! Create slime using the Mad Science recipe, and then enter the Slime Olympics to test your polymers. Probe the properties of light and explore some unusual applications of glow-in-the-dark technology! We will melt metal in boiling water and freeze water with just a breath of dry ice!</p>
<p align="center">Learn to Draw!!!</p> <p>Bring out the artist in your child! Learning to draw at a young age can teach your child to see his or her world in new ways. Learning to express oneself in new ways can stimulate self-awareness and encourage communication. Open the door for your child to learn the basic skills of line and contour drawing, composition, perspective, shading and sketching. In our class we will develop the habit of sketching and drawing the everyday things in our world and learn how to have fun without worrying about perfection.</p>	<p align="center">Mixed Media</p> <p>Color and texture make our world exciting! Give your child the opportunity to learn the basics of using different media to show you his or her impressions of the world.
