AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

CHESS W/MS. GILL! K-5 TH GRADE ON WEDNESDAYS	ONE ON ONE BASKETBALL K-5 TH GRADE ON THURSDAYS
Do you love to play games that challenge the mind? Then chess is the game for you. No experience necessary. Learn the history of the game, names of the pieces and how they move, great opening moves, the object of the game, and how to work pieces together. Moves, strategies, and checkmate patterns will be taught according to the readiness of participants. This class is designed for students of all ability levels. Marcia Gill is a 3rd grade teacher at Paden School and enjoys playing and teaching chess. Through chess, children are taught critical thinking, mental discipline, problem solving, and how to deal with winning and losing. Chess is fun!	Introducing AFTER SCHOOL HOOPS®, a weekday afternoon basketball program for aspiring young players. The one hour instructional sessions combine fundamental skills instruction with organized team competition with the goal of providing an enjoyable and educational after school athletic event. Developing players benefit by improving their individual skills such as passing, dribbling, shooting, rebounding, and defending while, at the same time, learning how to work within the framework of a team. Boys and girls of all skill levels are encouraged to join.
Carpentry K-5 TH GRADES ON FRIDAYS	Geography thro' Art 2-5 TH GRADE ON TUESDAYS
Students will discover the fun of building and working with wood. By building age appropriate projects the students will learn the safe and proper use of hand tools. They will discover the excitement of making useful and playful items for themselves and their families. Classes will begin by teaching simple skills such as using a hammer to drive nails, and move to each student successfully building a project that will range from a piece of furniture for a stuffed toy, to a foot stool or bird feeder.	This is an 6 week course, where we will study a continent each week. Then we will reinforce what we've learned through artwork. This will help develop an enriched understanding of each continent. As well as develop map and art skills. On the 6th week we will have a potluck with food from each continent and themed games.
DRAMA K ONLY & 1-5 TH ON WEDNESDAYS	Lego Engineering K-5 TH ON MONDAYS
In this 8-week session, there will be a concentration on voice/body relationship through improvisation skills, physical theatre skills and vocal technique. Students will work on monologues that they can use for future auditions for ACMT or Yirago Theatre Company productions. Monologue work will include learning to take direction, learning stage directions, taking risks, and developing good audition skills. Students will find comfort and confidence onstage. The session will end with a showcase of memorized monologues and demonstration of improv games.
